Democracy: a group exhibition

Hungry's Gallery is pleased to present *Democracy*, a group exhibition that will coincide with the 2008 presidential election. The opening reception for this exhibition will take place on Saturday, October 25, 2008 from 4 – 6 p.m. at Hungry's Gallery, 2356 Rice Blvd. in Houston, Texas. *Democracy* will be on view from October 25 – December 1, 2008.

Democracy is the brainchild of artist and gallery director Soody Sharifi, who invited all individuals – not just artists – to comment through photographic images on what democracy means to them as this important election approaches.
